I am a link in the Buddha's golden chain of love that stretches around the world. I must keep my link bright and strong. I will try to be kind and gentle to every living thing and protect all who are weaker than myself. I will try to think pure and beautiful thoughts, to say pure and beautiful words, and to do pure and beautiful deeds, knowing that on what I do now depends not only my happiness or unhappiness, but also that of others. May every link in the Buddha's golden chain of love become bright and strong, and may we all attain perfect peace.

#### Formula in Buddhism

Here is the formula when we learn the Teaching of Buddha. It goes as follows:

- 1. To learn Buddhism is to learn myself;
- 2. To learn myself is to learn Buddha's Compassion;
- 3. To learn the Compassion is to forget myself,
- 4. And to forget myself is to throw myself into Buddha's World.

**To learn Buddhism is to learn myself.** In other words, to learn Buddhism is to find myself in the Dharma. Or, I learn myself what I am and what I have been doing. You see the following two vows related to what I have been doing every second. Without the teaching of Buddha, it is hard for me to know what I have been doing exactly.

#### Vow #3

"If, when I attain Buddhahood, humans and devas in my land should not all be the color of pure gold, may I not attain perfect Enlightenment."

This vow tells me that I have attached, judged, and twisted people around me because of different skin colors. As long as I live, the teaching of Buddha tells me that I have to live with the attachment until the very moment I die. Then, is there any way to be freed from this attachment? Yes, there is. Know one thing as it is!

First, why do we see different skin colors in the world? According to a biological explanation, we see different skin colors because of Vitamin D. Our bodies need Vitamin D definitely, but the bodies cannot produce it without any sunlight. When the sunlight is strong, our skin adjusts its necessary amount for our bodies and our skins become darker just like sunglasses. When the sunlight is very strong, we need darker sunglasses. That's why people in hot countries have darker skin colors. We are, indeed, made of past conditions and lives in the past. If my ancestors lived in a hot country, my skin is dark.

Indeed, without accurate knowledge, we attach and judge people as we want. That's why the vow says that we are freed from the difference in skin color in Dharma. Dharma truly opens eyes of Wisdom in mind.
